Welcome to you if you have just moved on to New Braiswick Park!

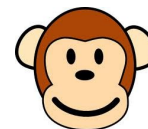
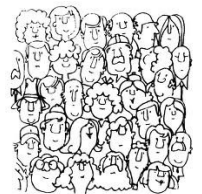

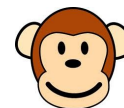
removed from their letterboxes.
